

Wild Ones Youth Ranch Volunteer Guidelines

1. Volunteers must have an ongoing relationship with Jesus Christ.
2. Volunteers must agree with and sign Wild Ones Youth Ranch's Statement of Faith.
3. All volunteers must fill out a volunteer application and secure two character references.
4. Volunteers must pass a criminal background check.
5. General ranch volunteers will be required to work 4 hours per month. Wranglers, Junior Wranglers, and Ranch Hands are subject to additional hourly requirements, to be defined by the director.
6. All youth advocates/counselors must be at least 3 years older than any child or teen they are supervising. Junior Wranglers or Ranch Hands may be younger than the preceding guidelines at the discretion of the directors.
7. Volunteers at overnight events must be the same gender as the youth or children they are supervising.
8. Volunteers must sign a Hold Harmless agreement for Wild Ones Youth Ranch, Kittyhawk Kigers, Windy Gates Property Management and Windy Gates Cattle Company each year.
9. Volunteers must submit to the authority of Wild Ones youth Ranch directors and their appointed representatives.
10. Volunteers understand that they represent Wild Ones Youth Ranch even while not on the premises and agree to conduct their lives in a manner consistent with the signed statement of faith.
11. All volunteers must undergo Wild Ones Youth Ranch volunteer training.
